**Briefing
Amadeus Operation**

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Order

Due to the violation of the article nº 8 S/RES/1718 (2006) of Virtual UN security, and in virtue to articles No 42 and 51 of the United Nations charter, authorizing the use of the force for the dismantling ballistic missile complex in North Korea. In the event of a military response by North Korea, is also authorized under Articles nº 42 and nº 51, the use of the force to repel these attacks.

According to Article No 43 paragraph 3 of the United Nations Charter, all the armies involved in **Amadeus Operation**, should be moved according to the following ordinances Air bases within the South Korea territory:

Rules of the Operation Amadeus

- The flight will have to be developed at night.
- All the flights will be start form Kaneda AB (Fukuoka) and finalized in the assigned air base according to you order.
- They were respected prohibited areas and the navigation charts available for the Korea theater.
- There are the authorized restricted areas you can crossing (see photos 1 and 5):
 - RJA 566
 - RJA 546 (A)
 - RJA 643
 - MOA13 EAST
- The airspace change form Japan to South Korea will be carried out by the ID POINT that it is marked pertinent navigation charts. (see photo 5).
- Briefing and mission will be sent to the respective people in charge of each swarm, being

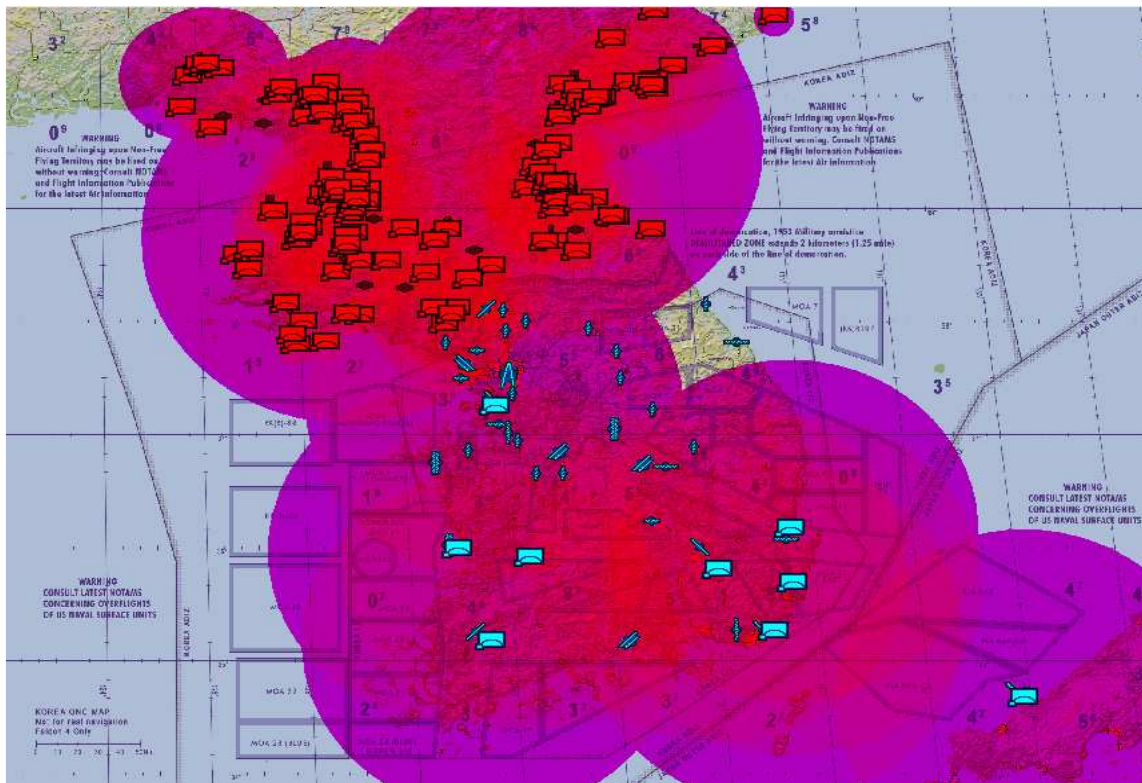


Photo 2. Present state of the air defenses to day 1 of campaign.

Korea of the north is one of the countries more defending than they exist at the present time. Its airspace strongly is protected. Intelligence informs that at the present time they are active most of the swarms of air defense on which counts the North Korean regime. SA-5, SA-3 and SA-2, along with the numerous battalions of AAA, they are the elements with which counts at the present time to repel air strikes.

The chosen allied air bases are outside the effective rank of their defenses. Even so, it will be necessary to carry far precautions during the movement. There are no present indications that can exist enemy air strikes or terrestrial attacks during these first stage.

It is anticipated that in the next hours, the air defenses of South Korea are increased and put in Maximum alert at the beginning of the hostile activities. As well, our unfolded ground troops in the zone, are put on the alert watching the demilitarized zone and ready to repel any attack by earth that can be organized in the next hours.

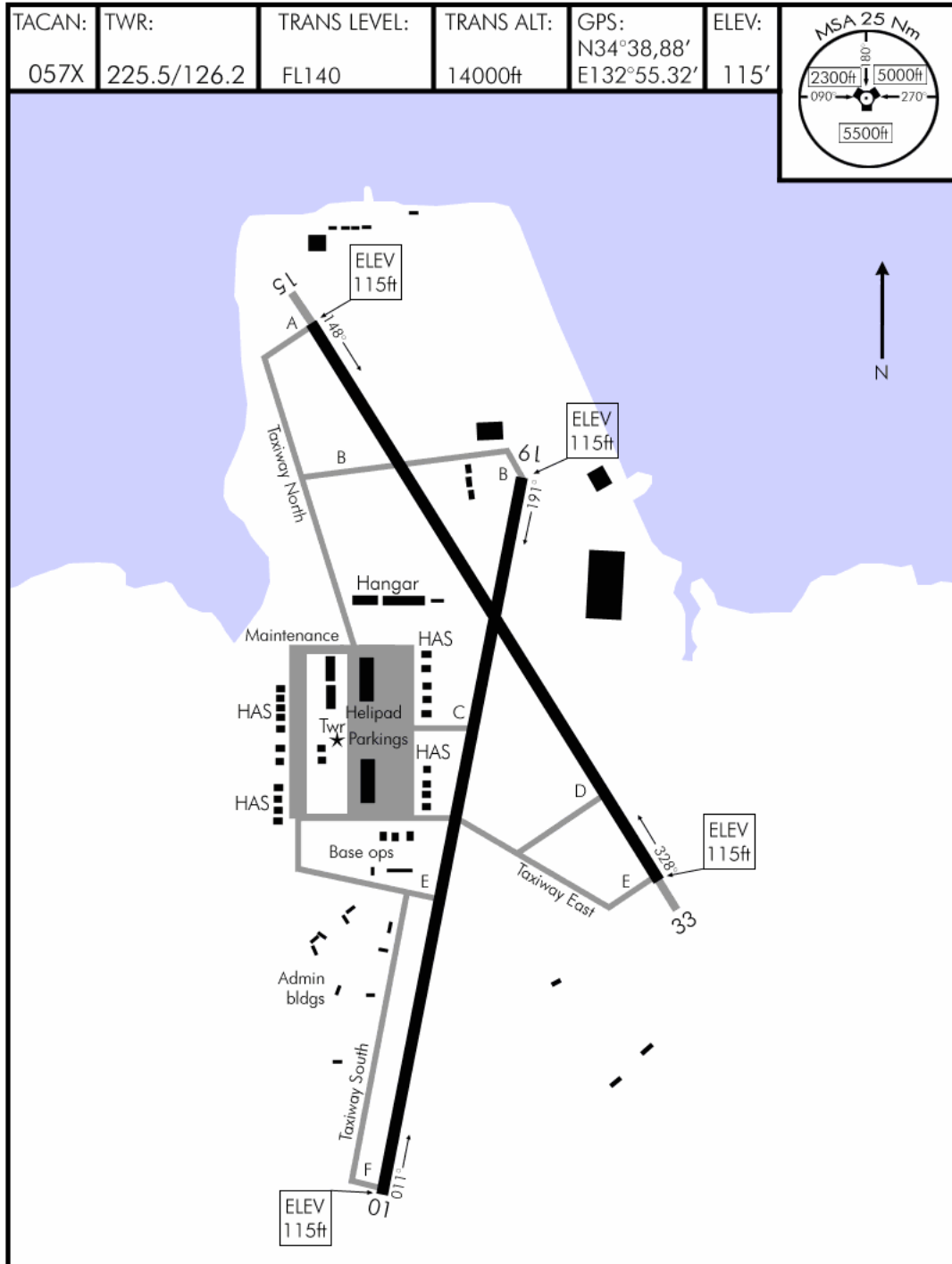
When we established all the swarms in its respective operational bases, You will receive your order of battle of North Korea forces

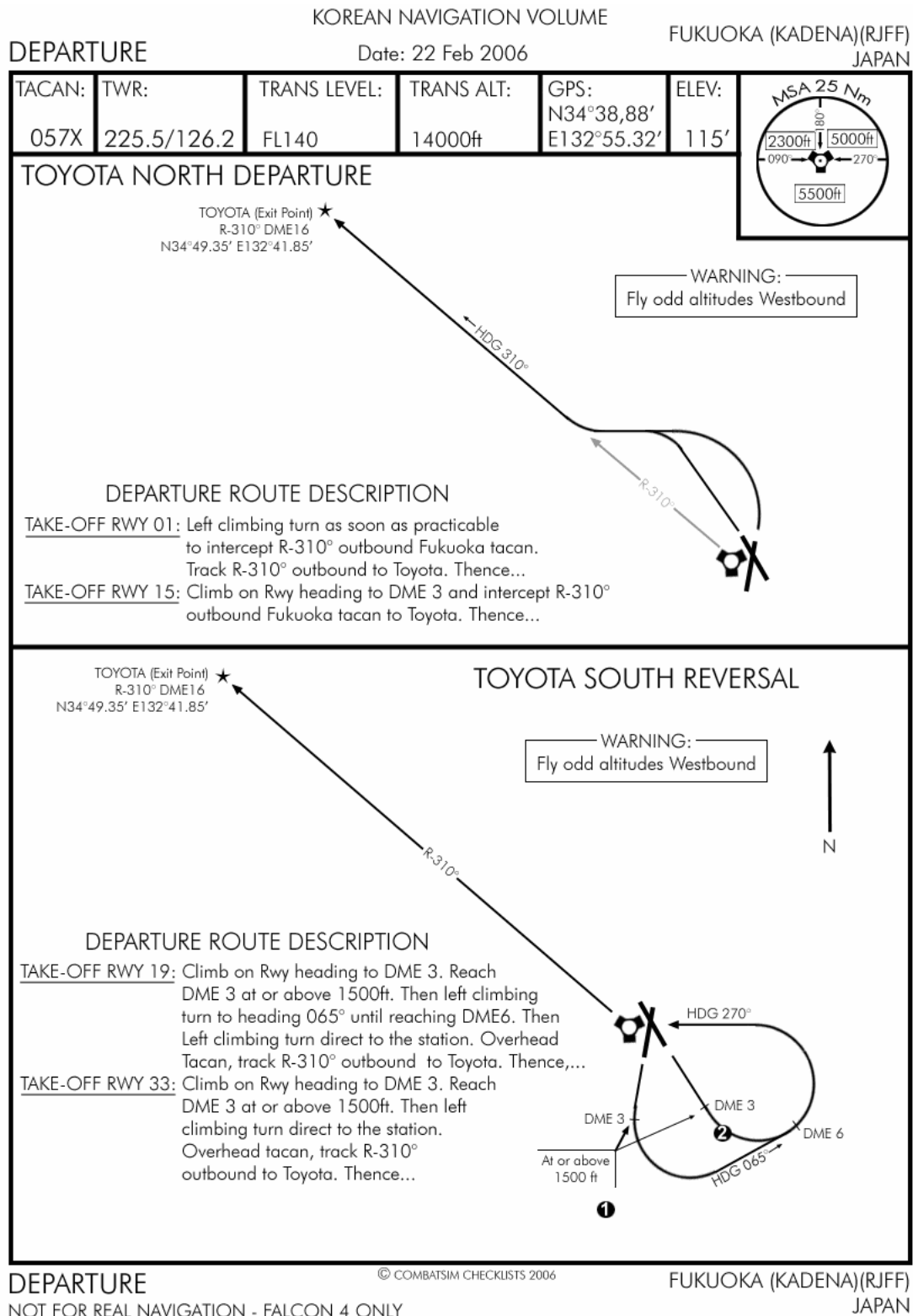

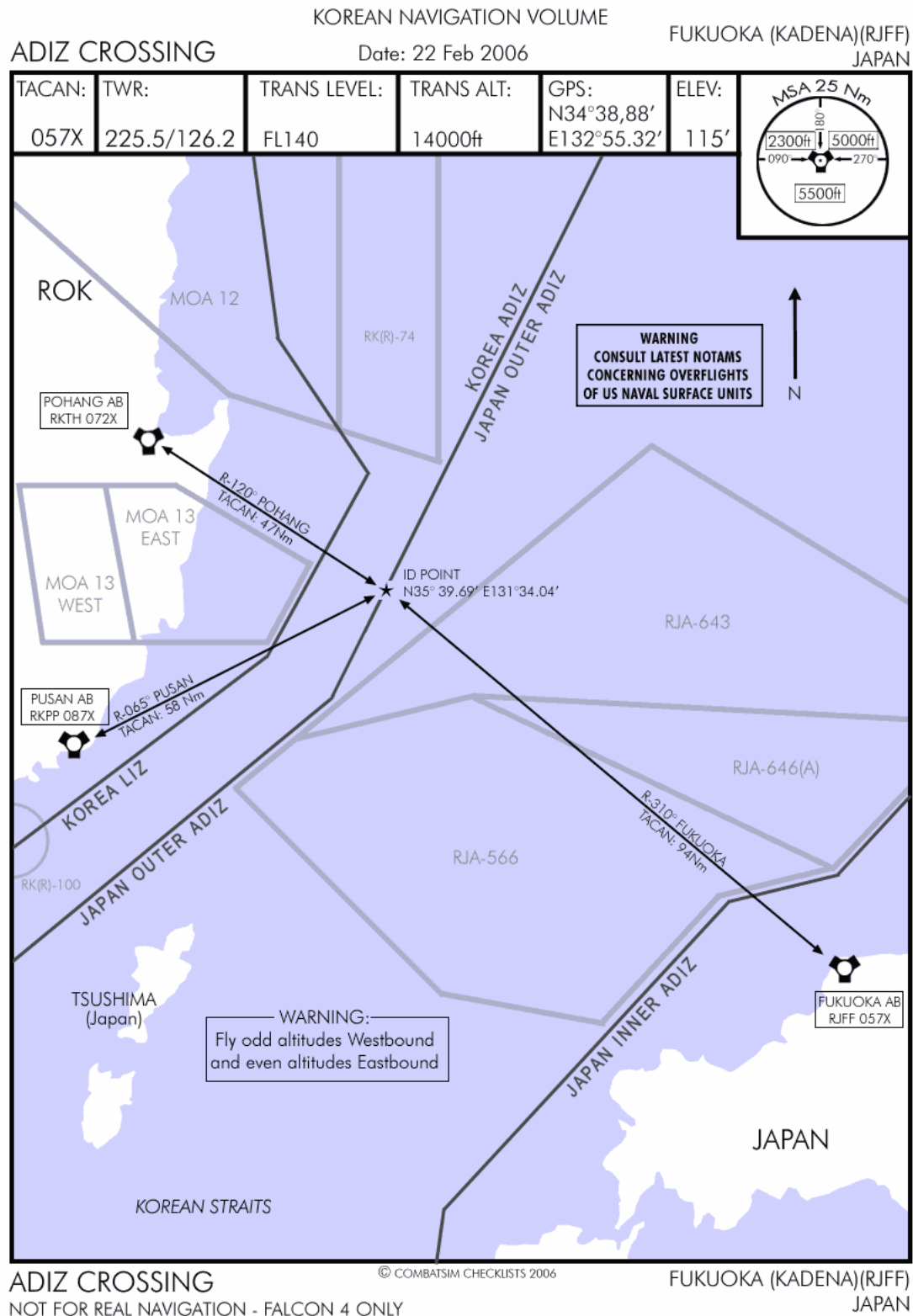


Photo 5. Position of *ID POINT* to enter South Korean airspace.

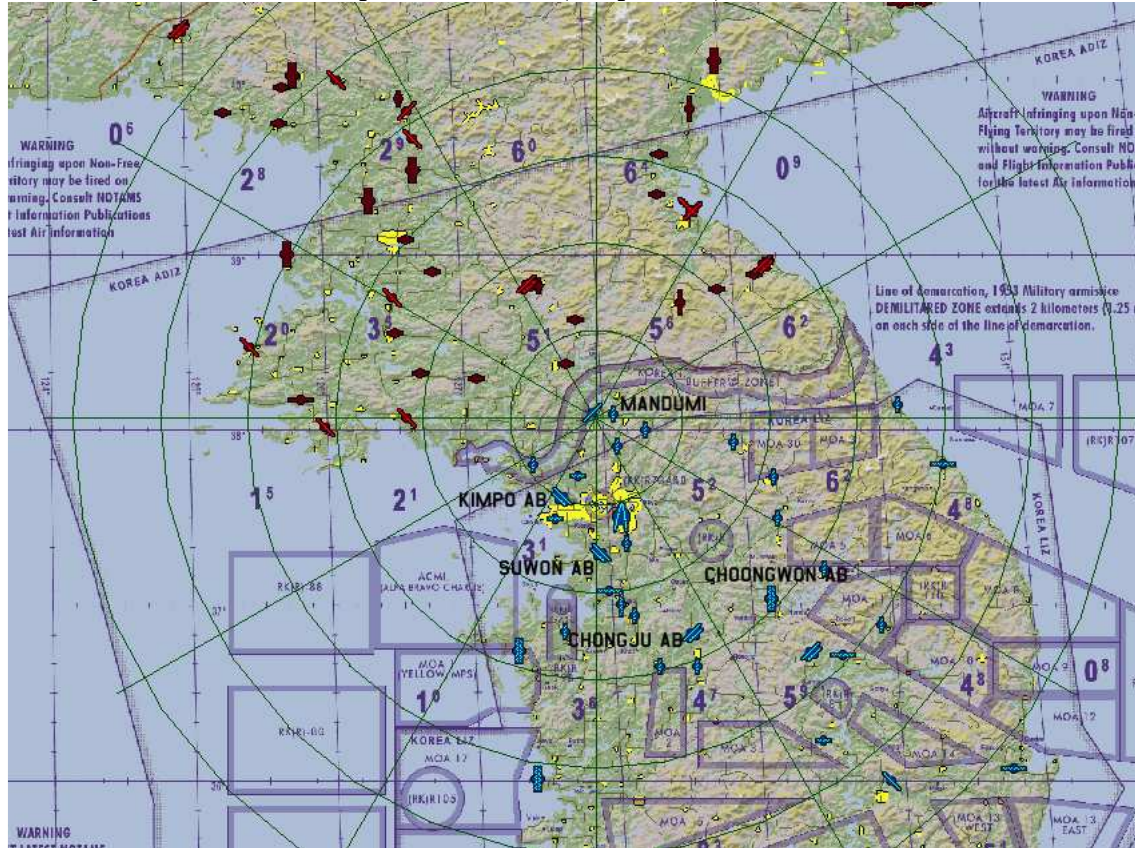


Photo 6: Mandumi Bullseye & Situation of air bases.
